

### Real Life Hero's

Hatred Traded for Happiness Idrie Kiah Bangladesh 1995

"My name is Idris Miah. I have a wife named Rahana and four girls, ages seven, five, three, and one. I was a good Muslim man, but I knew a bad Muslim man named Abu Bakkar Sidhikki who would often get drunk. No one in our village liked him, but what Abu eventually did made us hate him: he became a Christian. Some Christian men had visited his house and told him about Jesus. Abu then accepted Jesus and became a Christian. "The village leaders met and decided that what he did was so bad that we would have to kick him out of our village and bum down his house. We formed a group of twentyfive men and went to his house. We were sneaking up to his house to take him by surprise. "As we got closer we could hear him praying. He was actually praying for our whole village. He was asking Jesus to forgive everyone in the village. He said Jesus should forgive us because we did not know what we were doing. This made us angry because we thought we knew what we were doing. Then all twenty-five of us rushed to his house to apprehend him, but there was an invisible force that would not let any of us enter his house to drag him out. We all became scared and everyone ran back to his own house. "When I got home I could not sleep. I kept thinking about Abu's prayer. He said we did not know what we were doing. Was it true? Was he right? I tossed and turned but could not get this experience out of my mind. Finally, at 3:00 A.M. I could not wait any longer. I went back to Abus house and said, 'Who is Jesus?' "He told me how Jesus gave his life for sinners and how I could be saved. After three hours of this, I asked Jesus to forgive me and I surrendered my life to him. Jesus saved me! "I rushed to my house and shared what happened to me with my wife and she also became a Christian along with my children. "As the news of our conversion spread, the village leaders, including my father-in-law, condemned us. They said that no one can hire me to work in their fields. I am poor and do not own any land to farm myself. Ii no one will hire me, how can I support my family? They said they will give me seven days to change my mind and become a Muslim again, or they will kick us out of the village. Thank God they haven't done this yet. My children have already been kicked out of school because we became Christians. "I have the joy of Jesus in my heart. I give my life and my family to Jesus. I hope this gift is acceptable to my Lord."

If people persecute you because you are a Christian, don't curse them; pray that God will bless them. When others are happy, be happy with them. If they are sad, share their sorrow... Don't let evil get the best of you, but conquer evil by doing good. Paul the Apostle Martyred In Rome, 65 AD (ROMANS 12:14,15.21 NIT)



## WISDOM

#### EXTREME APPLICATION

#### Think About it (The Tension of Wisdom)

What does the world say is wise? What does the Bible say is wise?

There is tension in between these to view points.

Think about it, the world says to take care of yourself and promote yourself at all cost. Live more comfortable each year no matter what. But Jesus tells us to serve it to lead and when we serve others we are leading. The world says that a leader is served by others. Confusing, yes it can be.

Take a look at Romans 12:1-2 1 Therefore, I urge you, brothers, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as living sacrifices, holy and pleasing to God-this is your spiritual act of worship. 2 Do not conform any longer to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is -his good, pleasing and perfect will. There is tension in this verse because we live in this world and it is hard to not be shaped by it, but we are to live for something more! We are to be shaped and transformed by God's word. When we choose to live in wisdom we are saying that we are choosing to live the way that God would have us live. We are saying that wisdom only comes from God! He is the giver of wisdom and when we live by God and from God we are in opposition of the world. The world does not follow God's wisdom, it follows the worlds wisdom. There will be tension we we follow God. But in that tension we also find freedom as we live the way that God would have us live. Making the right decision starts with asking God for Wisdom and then it only becomes wisdom when you put it into action. Action, wisdom lived out! Making the right decision because you choose to follow God.

Tension will come but in the end making good decisions will lead you the right way every time!
