"Do you understand what I have done for you?" he asked them. 13 "You call me 'Teacher' and 'Lord,' and rightly so, for that is what I am. 14 Now that I, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also should wash one another's feet. 15 I have set you an example that you should do as I have

done for you. 16 I tell you the truth, no servant is greater than his master, nor is a messenger greater than the one who sent him. 17 Now that you know these things, you will be blessed if you do them. Wow that is awesome, the Son of God washing your feet. I mean we all sort of get the great mission to take on the worlds sin and defeat the thief but to wash our feet. That is pretty awesome step to go to, so that the world would know what it means to be a servant leader. It's fashioned from watching parents who still care about their starving friends in Russia. It's uncontrollably lived out before others. Angie teaches us a great lesson about devotion.
